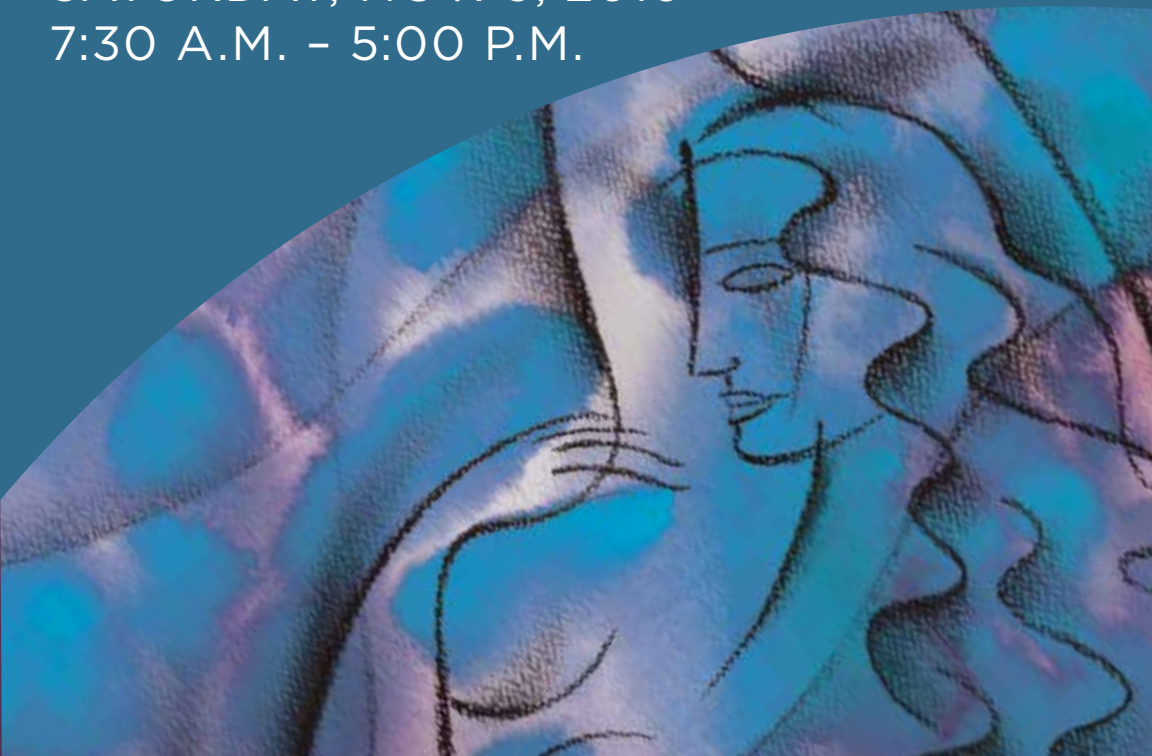

COURSE DESCRIPTION AND STATEMENT OF NEED

Plastic and reconstructive surgical and nonsurgical procedures vary widely. Patient needs range from correction of birth defects to facial rejuvenation, accidents to rhinoplasty, scar revision to body contouring – and all require a unique skill set and experience. This demand for aesthetic procedures and reconstruction gives rise to numerous new technologies and techniques; however, keeping pace with such advances can be challenging. This year's program will feature content about two hot topic areas: facial transplants and sexual reassignment surgery. Expert guest faculty will present clinical insights and share their professional experience in these uniquely complex and challenging areas of plastic surgery.

TARGET AUDIENCE
